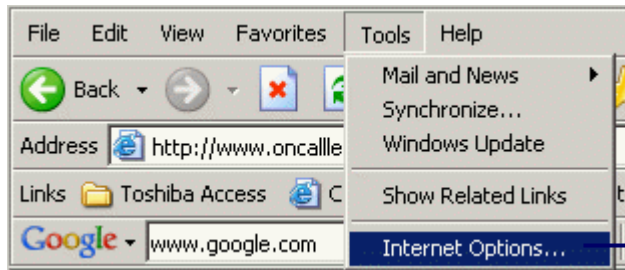


How To Install the DemoNow Plug-In

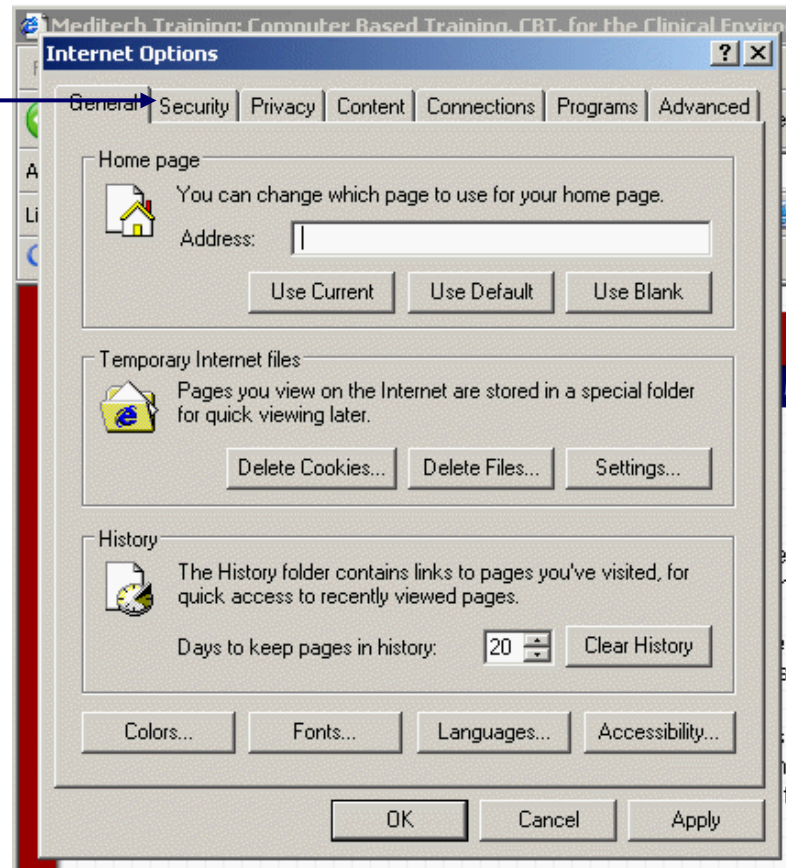
If the DemoNow plug-in was not automatically installed, follow the steps listed below to update your Internet Explorer settings.

Change Internet Security Settings

1) Open Internet Explorer, and under the Tools menu button select Internet Options.

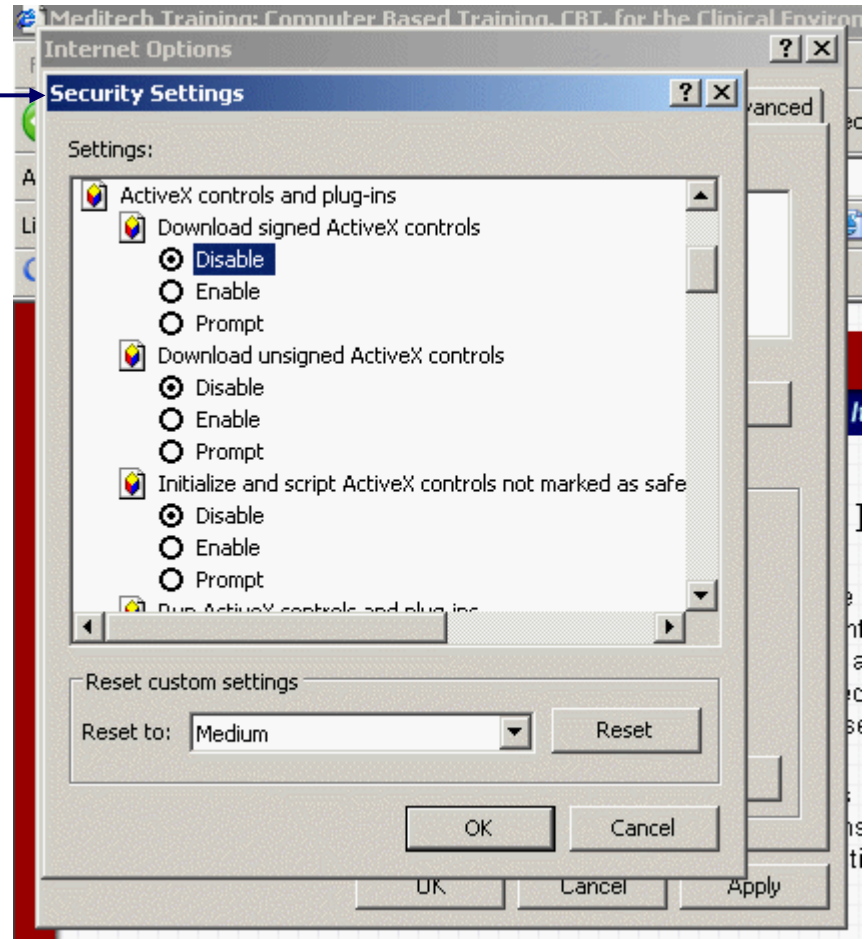
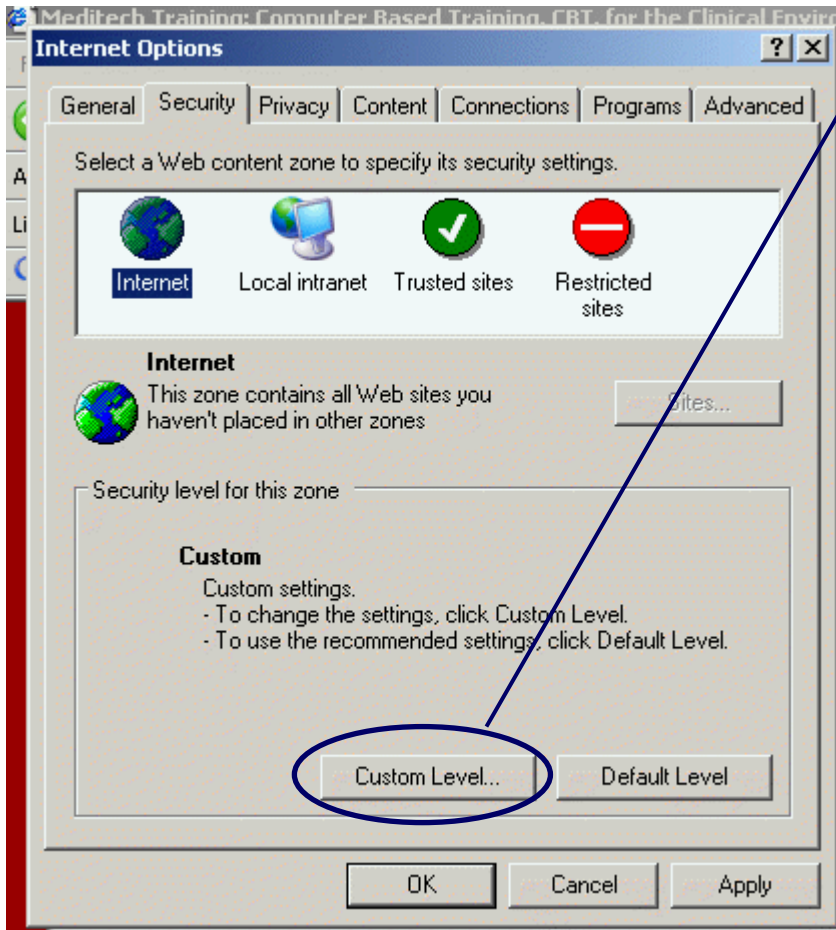


2) Select the Security tab

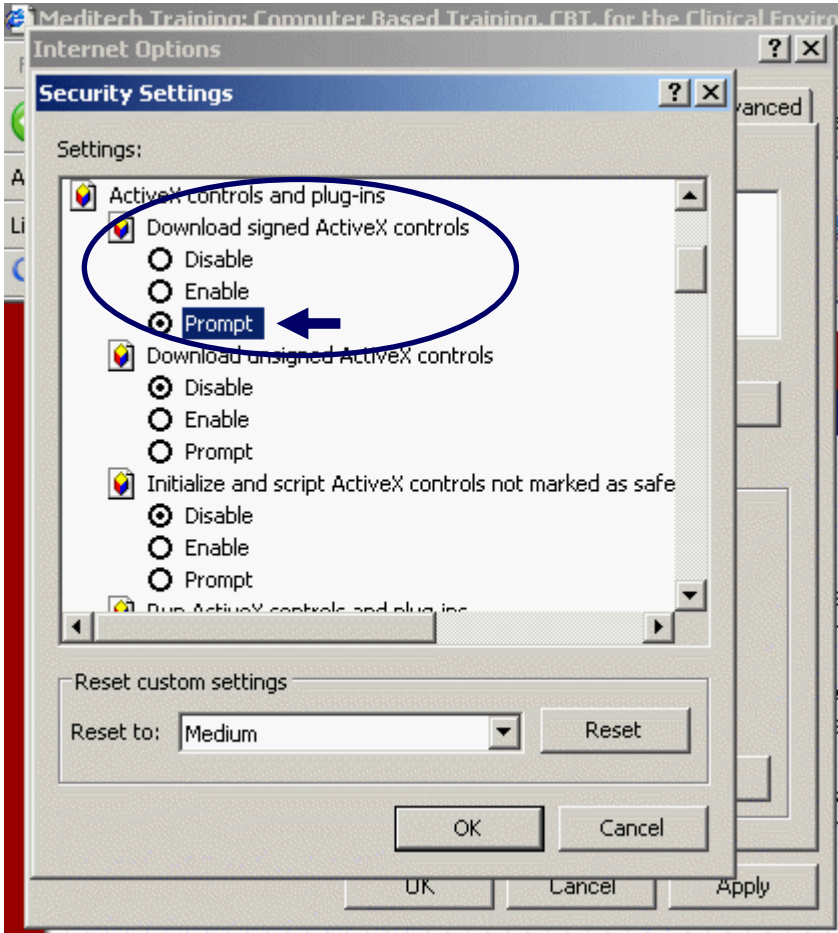


3) Under the Security tab, select Custom Level...

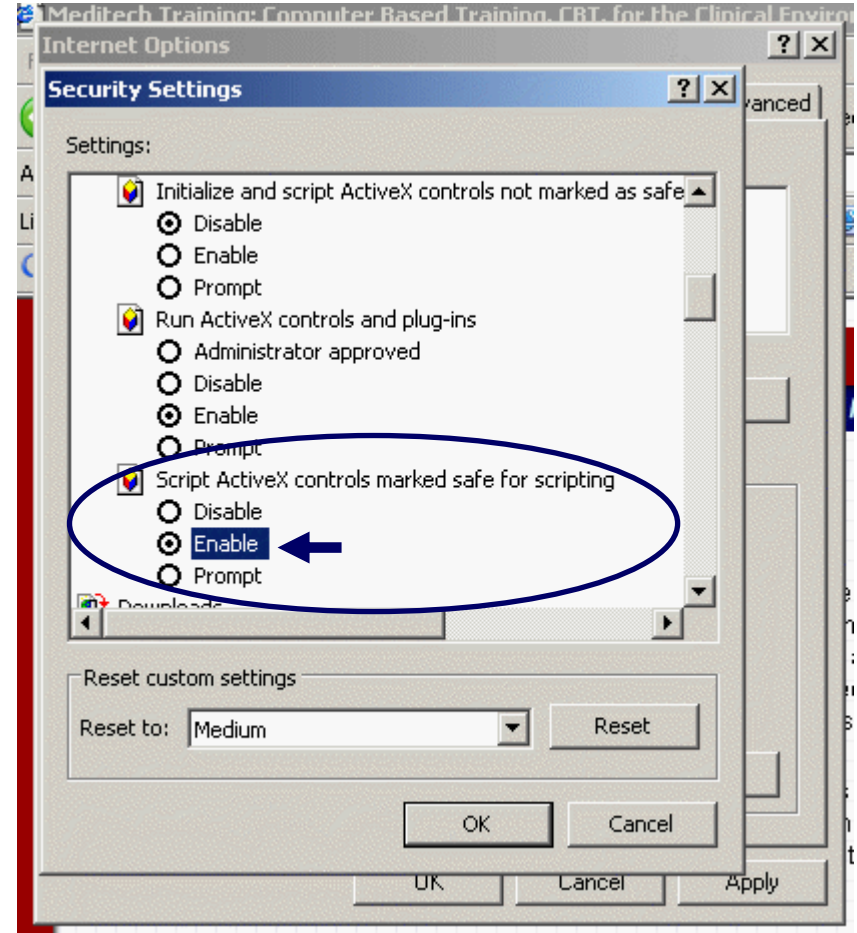
4) In the Security Settings window, scroll down until "ActiveX controls and plug-ins" is displayed



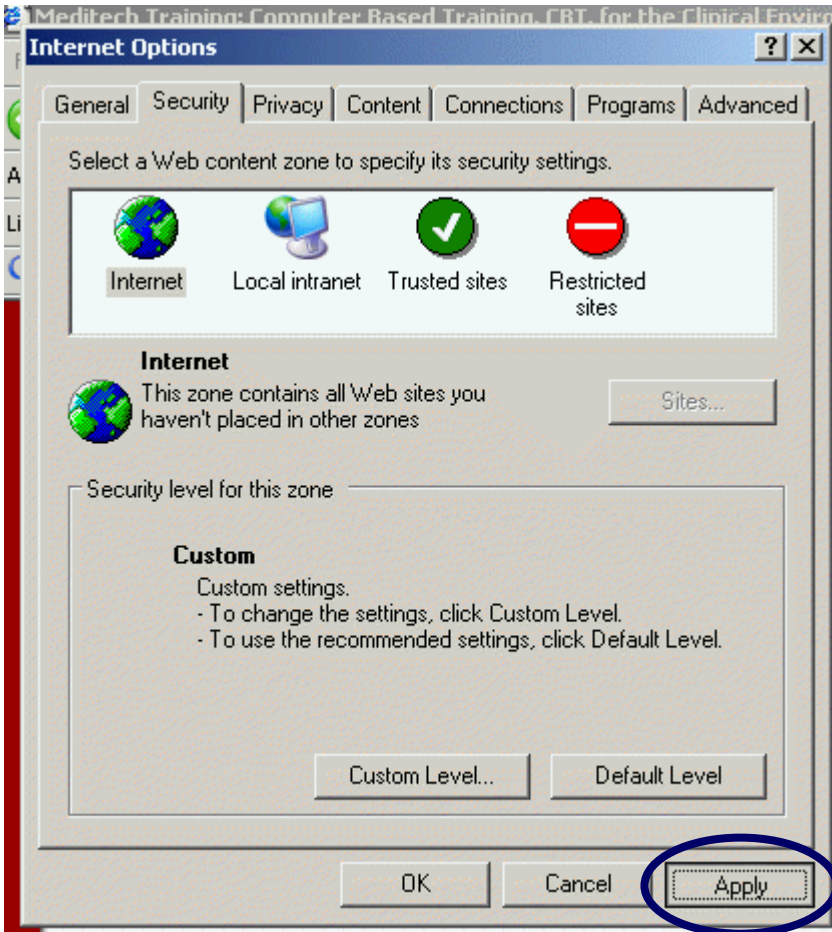
5) Under "Download signed ActiveX controls" select "Prompt"



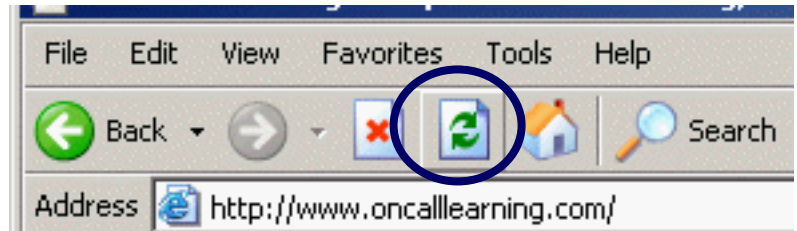
6) Scroll down and select "Enable" under "Script ActiveX controls marked safe for scripting"



7) Click on OK to exit the Security Settings window and click Apply to permanently apply the settings.



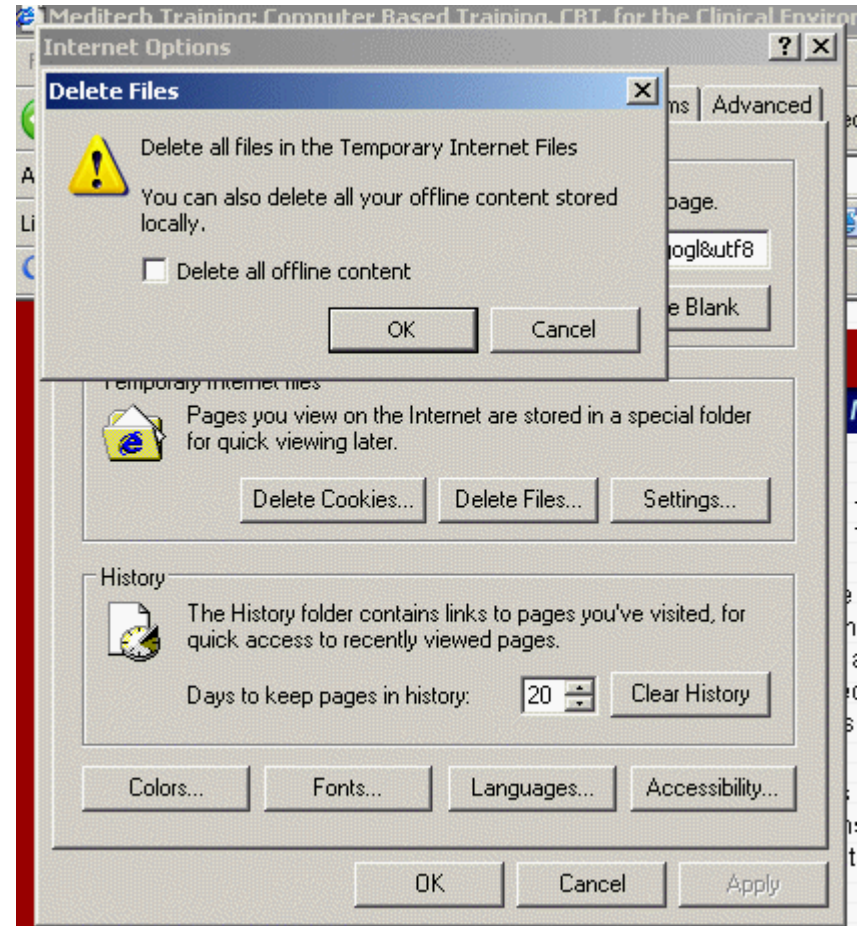
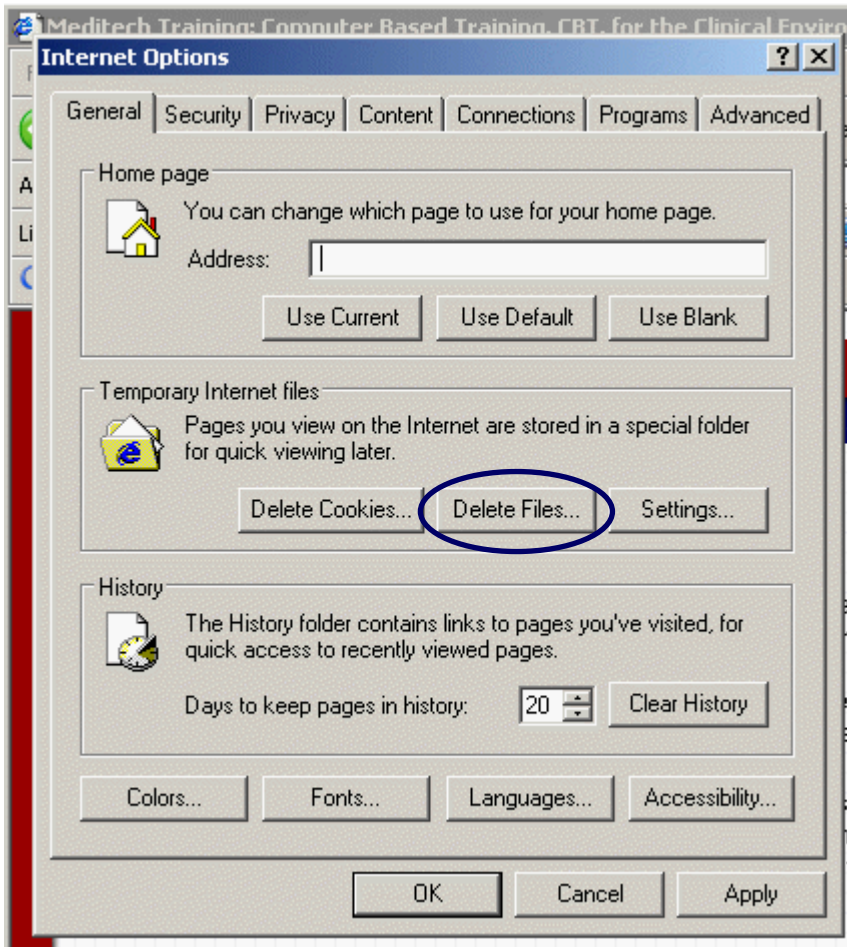
8) To ensure that the settings have been applied to the page, refresh your internet window.



If you are still having problems viewing the DemoNow files:

1) Return to the Internet Options menu and click "Delete Files" under "Temporary Internet Files"

2) In the new window that pops up, click "OK" to clear your Temporary Internet Files.
